Fees

Course fees is usually the largest portion of costs when it comes to studying, we understand this and have worked closely with federal and state government bodies to source funding for many of our nationally accredited courses. Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) for VET courses

If you wish to apply for Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) in one of our VET accredited courses, this will be treated as 50% of the UOS. VET FEE-HELP assistance may be available to eligible students applying for RPL into any of our approved courses. More information on RPL is available [here](#).

VET Student Loans

VET Student Loans is a government loan scheme that is expected to be repaid and impacts upon a student's credit rating, VET Student Loans can financially assist eligible students undertaking certain VET courses of study (diploma, advanced diploma, graduate certificate and graduate diploma courses). Eligible students who choose BCA National as their training provider will be able to borrow funds up to the loan cap for each course, within the limits of the students FEE-HELP balance, to help pay for all or part of their tuition fees.

You will only be charged for the UOS you are engaged with, participating in and intending to complete. If you are marked as at risk after Census one, you will not be progressively charged until you have noted you wish to continue with your enrolment and we have this on record.
